What is a Cystogram procedure?

A cystogram is primarily a study to evaluate the urinary bladder. Contrast is injected through a catheter, which has been placed in the bladder via the urethra. As the bladder fills, x-ray images are taken. You may feel a very full feeling. Once the bladder is filled adequately and necessary images are taken, the catheter will be removed and you may void. The exam takes approximately 30-45 minutes.

Preparation:

Inform your physician if you have any allergies to x-ray contrast. After the procedure it is important you drink plenty of liquids.

Follow-Up:

1. Notify your physician if you develop a fever or possible urinary tract infections.
2. Drink plenty of liquids.

Parking/Registration:

Park in the Mercy Medical Center 10th Street Parking Ramp, located at the corner of 10th Street and 8th Ave. SE. You will be pre-registered, so you can proceed to **Ground (G)** level and follow the signs to "Radiology (X-Ray)," also located on Ground (G) level.

Procedure Results (Who interprets the results):

A radiologist will review the images shortly after the exam is completed. A written report will be sent to your doctor. Your doctor will discuss the results with you. Please allow your physician time to review these results, usually 2 business days after the exam.
