What is a Functional Renal Scan?

A renal scan is performed to evaluate the function of the kidneys.

Preparation:

Each renal exam has different requirements. Please consult your physician for specific direction.

A LIST OF CURRENT MEDICATIONS YOU ARE TAKING

Procedure:

1. Upon arrival, an IV port will be established in a vein in your arm.
2. You will then be placed on the imaging table with the camera head placed under the table at the level of your mid-back.
3. You will be injected with a radiotracer and images will start immediately.
4. Imaging will be performed for 30 minutes.
5. Depending on the type of exam ordered, lasix might be administered during imaging.
6. If your physician wants to see a comparison between when a particular blood pressure medicine is being taken and when you are off the medications, another set of images will be obtained for another 30 minutes. Please consult your physician for specifics.

Parking/Registration:

Park in the Mercy Medical Center 10th Street Parking Ramp, located at the corner of 10th Street and 8th Ave. SE. You will be pre-registered, so you can proceed to **Ground (G)** level and follow the signs to "Radiology (X-Ray)," also located on Ground (G) level.

Procedure Results (Who interprets the results):

A radiologist will review the images shortly after the exam is completed. A written report will be sent to your doctor. Your doctor will discuss the results with you. Please allow your physician time to review these results, usually 2 business days after the exam.

What is a DMSA Renal Exam?

A DMSA Renal exam is used to visualize the kidneys. This exam is specifically used to evaluate the anatomy of the kidneys for patients with reflux. It can also be used to evaluate kidney masses.

Preparation:

1. Patient needs to be well hydrated prior to the scan and continue to hydrate for at least 24 hours.

A LIST OF CURRENT MEDICATIONS YOU ARE TAKING

Procedure:

1. Upon arrival, you will be injected with radiotracer and asked to return in 4-5 hours for imaging.
2. Upon your return, you will be placed on the imaging table with the camera head placed under the table at the level of your mid-back.
3. A series of images will be taken lasting 30 minutes.

Parking/Registration:

Park in the Mercy Medical Center 10th Street Parking Ramp, located at the corner of 10th Street and 8th Ave. SE. You will be pre-registered, so you can proceed to **Ground (G)** level and follow the signs to "Radiology (X-Ray)," also located on Ground (G) level.
