What is a CT Enterography Procedure?

This is a scan of the abdomen and pelvis, specifically looking at the small bowel.

Preparation:

Do not eat or drink anything four hours before your exam.

Procedure:

One hour before your exam you will be given a solution to drink (Volumen) that will coat your small bowel for the exam. Also, an IV contrast is used that will be injected at the time of the exam. If you are over 60, diabetic or have high blood pressure, a blood test called Serum Creatinine is needed. This can be done within 30 days prior to the exam or at the time of the exam.
