What is a Breast Ultrasound?

Ultrasound is an easy and noninvasive way to visualize the breast tissue. It uses high-frequency soundwaves to produce images of the breast.

Why Should I have a Breast Ultrasound?

Breast ultrasound is used to view abnormalities that are identified on a mammogram. Breast ultrasound is able to determine if an area on the mammogram is cystic or solid. Breast ultrasound is also used to evaluate an area of concern that you may feel.
