When You Discover a Fire

**R** - Rescue  
**A** - Alarm  
**C** - Contain  
**E** - Evacuate

CODE ALERTS	Dial 6111
Code RED = FIRE	
Code BLUE = Medical Emergency	
Code GREEN = Aggressive Incident	
Code GRAY = Severe Weather	
Code SILVER = Armed Intruder	
Code PINK = Child/Adult Abduction	
Code WHITE = Civil Disturbance	
Code ORANGE = Hazardous Material	

- **Code Blue:** Medical Emergency/Cardiac Arrest
- **Code Gray:** Severe Weather - Please proceed down to the lowest level or an inner area away from windows, do not take the elevator, use the stairwell to get to the lowest level possible.
- **Code Green:** Aggressive Incident - Code Green is used for persons who have become verbally or physically aggressive with another patient, visitor or staff and where aggressive behavior is occurring or is imminent.
- **Code Orange:** Hazardous Material
- **Code Pink:** Adult/Child Abduction - Proceed to the nearest outside door, stand inside, **NO ONE** comes in or goes out until an all clear is sounded, the code will indicate if it is a man/woman, child/infant including the floor they are missing from. Notify Telecom at 6111 if you see anyone fitting the description given or if someone attempts to leave the building.
- **Code Red:** FIRE - R.A.C.E. (Rescue, Alarm, Contain, Evacuate or Extinguish (only if you are trained to do so)).
- **Code Silver** - Armed Intruder - Exit out of the hallways and out of the building if able. Listen to the overhead announcement to determine your proximity to the event. Do not get on an elevator or use the stairways if you are near the area of the intruder. If needed, hide in an office, lock the door, turn off the lights and do not walk back and forth in front of the locked door. Barricade the door if able and hide under a desk until an all clear has been sounded.
