What is an Ultrasound?

Ultrasound is an easy and noninvasive way to see internal structures of the body. Ultrasound sends high frequency sound waves through the skin and produces images of major organs and blood vessels.

Why should I have an Ultrasound Guided Biopsy?

Ultrasound is used to guide the doctor to an area in the body (such as thyroid, liver, breast or kidneys) to obtain a tissue sample to check for abnormalities. A biopsy will take 30-60 minutes.

Preparation:

If you are on blood thinning medications, such as aspirin, these will need to be discontinued for 7 days with approval from your physician.

Parking/Registration:

Park in the Mercy Medical Center 10th Street Parking Ramp, located at the corner of 10th Street and 8th Ave. SE. You will be pre-registered, so you can proceed to **Ground (G)** level and follow the signs to "Radiology (X-Ray)," also located on Ground (G) level.

Procedure Results (Who interprets the results):

A radiologist will review the images shortly after the exam is completed. A written report will be sent to your doctor. Your doctor will discuss the results with you. Please allow your physician time to review these results, usually 2 business days after the exam.
