What is a Fistula Sinus Tract Study?

A fistula sinus tract study will examine a sinus cavity to check for leakage and/or size of the cavity. This procedure will take approximately 30 minutes.

Preparation:

No preparation is necessary. The patient may want to bring extra wound/dressing supplies if desired.

Procedure:

The radiologist will insert a small foley catheter into the sinus tract, inject contrast material and then take x-ray images to evaluate the sinus cavity.

Parking/Registration:

Park in the Mercy Medical Center 10th Street Parking Ramp, located at the corner of 10th Street and 8th Ave. SE. You will be pre-registered, so you can proceed to **Ground (G)** level and follow the signs to "Radiology (X-Ray)," also located on **Ground (G)** level.
